Proposed Amendments to HOBC Constitution

3/29/05 Submitted by: Marc LeBlanc

13. Use of guides on the tournament lake is prohibited three (3) weeks prior to the tournament. Exceptions to the rule:

1. The rule to be waved for the challenge tournament.
2. The rule may be waved by a club vote (vote of members in good standing and in attendance at the club meeting) if the tournament site is changed.

3. The rule to be waved when a club tournament is in conjunction with an Oilfield tournament such as the TOBI, LOBI and ROC. In this situation, the guide rules will be the same as the rules of the Oilfield tournament.
