It runs great and will go about 70 mph. It is ready to fish and very clean. I have all the maintenance records on it and you can see that it was well maintained. The dealer that I bought it from showed me a printout that said it was worth \$10,500. That is about the price that most comparable boats are listed on boat trader for. I am willing to sell it for \$8,500 so I can get it out of my storage unit. If you know anyone interested, you can get them a deal for \$8,500. Starting next week, I am booked solid until May. I would like to sell it this week. The <http://www.nadaguides.com> website shows that the average retail on this boat with a 120 hp is \$8,000. This boat is well above average and has a 150 hp motor.
